**OUT OF COUNCIL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ORDEAL CANDIDATES:** You must have been elected to the Order of the Arrow by your Troop in your home Council. Then you must obtain your Troop's and home OA Lodge's permission, which is required for an out-of-council Ordeal and induction. Assuming election, your Unit Leader must request a change for you in Ordeal Completion, so that you may complete your Ordeal in the Malibu Lodge of the Western Los Angeles County Council. This request must be made **in advance** and in writing to both your home Lodge and to Malibu Lodge. The request might state:

"[Scout name] has been elected as a candidate for membership in the Order of the Arrow in [name of his home lodge]. For religious or other reasons, [Scout name] desires to participate in an Ordeal and induction ceremony in the Western Los Angeles County Council at its 2008 Kinnus. [Scoutmaster] and [Scout's home lodge] request and give permission to Malibu Lodge to conduct this ceremony on our behalf and to include [Scout Name] in the Sabbath observant and Kosher OA activities at BSA Camp Josepho."

Telephone: 310-338-1171 x 10 for further handling.) After induction, you will receive from Malibu Lodge an Ordeal Sash, a handbook, and proof of induction. Upon return home, you should present your proof of induction to your home Lodge, pay your dues and other appropriate fees for special items unique to your lodge, and receive a membership card from your registered Council Lodge.

- Knit Cap And Warm Gloves
- Ground Cloth
- Flashlight
- Official Scout Uniform (To Be Worn To Camp)
- Work Clothes
- Sturdy shoes or work boots
- Work Gloves
- Hat
- Knife And Tote-N-Chip Card
- Tools (Make Sure They Are Labeled)

If any items are needed for medical reasons please complete the medical form and inform the staff. Any items found that are inappropriate to the Ordeal will be confiscated for the duration of the weekend. All candidates must complete a medical form to participate.

## ADDITIONAL NOTES:

1. Please do not bring food to the camp, due to strict observance of dietary laws. Strictly Kosher meals will be supervised, prepared and provided by the volunteer staff of the concurrent Kinnus.
2. Ordeal candidates and Arrowmen should arrive in uniform.
3. This special Ordeal is taking place in conjunction with a Religious Retreat of the Jewish Committee on Scouting of the Western Los Angeles County Council. Every person should put into practice the twelfth point of the Scout Law, reverence, respecting one's own religious beliefs and respecting the religious beliefs of others at the camp if different from your own.
4. There will be Jewish religious services taking place as a part of the Kinnus weekend. If because of your religious practices you wish to attend those services, you are welcome to do so. Please bring your own Siddur, Kippah, Tallit and T'fillin if you wish to have and use them.
5. Arrival time is set for 8:30 PM on Saturday night, May 24, 2008. Please be aware of several time conflicts. Havdalah and evening services will be underway for the Kinnus from about 8:40 PM to 9:15 PM, followed by a ceremony to lower the U.S. flag and other activities for the Kinnus participants. Please arrive in camp before 9:00 PM, but please be quiet and do not disturb any religious services underway. Also, please do not interfere with the activities of the Kinnus thereafter.
