Update from our Health and Safety Committee

3/21/22 Update

Effective immediately, WLACC will no longer require masking for indoor events. All scouts and guests who feel they want to wear a mask for personal or family reasons, are encouraged to wear a surgical or N-95 mask. No scout or guest should be made to feel uncomfortable because of their personal choice.

Remember these points of the Scout Law: a scout is Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Clean and Reverent. Bullying will not be tolerated in Scouting.

Pre-screening upon entry to a meeting or event will no longer be required. (See Camp specific information below). All scouts and guests are asked to not come to a meeting or event of any kind, under the activities of WLACC, if you are positive for any COVID-19 type symptoms. Every one of us in scouting needs to pay attention during our activities to keep everyone safe from any further COVID surges.

Summer camp will require a Camp Unit Pre-Screening form to be submitted with other camp related medical forms. If you have any symptoms, you are being asked not to come to camp. We are planning to open WLACC summer camps to full registration for the 2022 season.

We want to thank you all for your patience throughout the past two plus years of COVID-19 Surges and declines.

You have all been very successful in keeping Scouting alive and maintaining it as the outstanding program for youth that we know it to be.
